Dive safari

In Bali, you can dive in and around the famous USAT Liberty wreck dating back to the Second World War 1941-1942 (Tulamben). On a drop off, on white sand (Menjangan), across small islands (Gilis : Biaha, Mimpang and Tepekong), in 'washing machine' currents or in a peaceful bays, on coral gardens (Blue Lagoon) or drift dive sites to see the most famous pelagic of Bali Mola Mola (or sunfish in Nusa Penida)

if you are a beginner or an advanced diver, fan of macro or admirer of the pelagic, lover of the underwater world, photographer or those who prefer muck dives, everything you wish for is here in Bali



DAY 1 Transfer in Airport - Sanur

Sanur is an ideal place to stay for families and travelers who are looking to stay away from the more upbeat and crowded areas, such as Kuta, Seminyak or Canggu. However, there is still plenty to do, and Sanur is lively and offers everything a traveler desires. The nightlife is more relaxed while there are plenty of bars that feature live bands. The traditional Shindu night market is also one of the iconic place tourist must visit and the new Icon Mall in Sanur beach is a nice place for shopping or just to stroll around. And you need to know that Sanur is best place to enjoy the beautiful **sunrise!**

DAY 2 : Relocation Sanur - Pemuteran

On your first morning in Bali, begin your journey to the northwest. The journey through the central highlands, passing rice fields amidst the mountains, will make your journey even more enjoyable. You will also make some stops to **Tanah Lot, the Temple by the beach and The Lake of Bedugul.**

DAY 3 : Menjangan Island 3x Boat Dives

Menjangan Island, is part of the West Bali National Park, renowned for its stunning dives and snorkeling, characterized by clear, warm waters, abundant marine life, and vibrant coral formations. Diving into the magnificent wall which start shallow and descend to depths of 50 meters / 160 feet or more, offer diverse underwater landscapes, including caves, overhangs, and slopes, adorned with soft corals, sponges, and gorgonian fans. Visibility is often excellent, and the area is known for its gentle currents, making it suitable for divers of all levels.

DAY 4 : Relocation Pemuteran - Tulamben

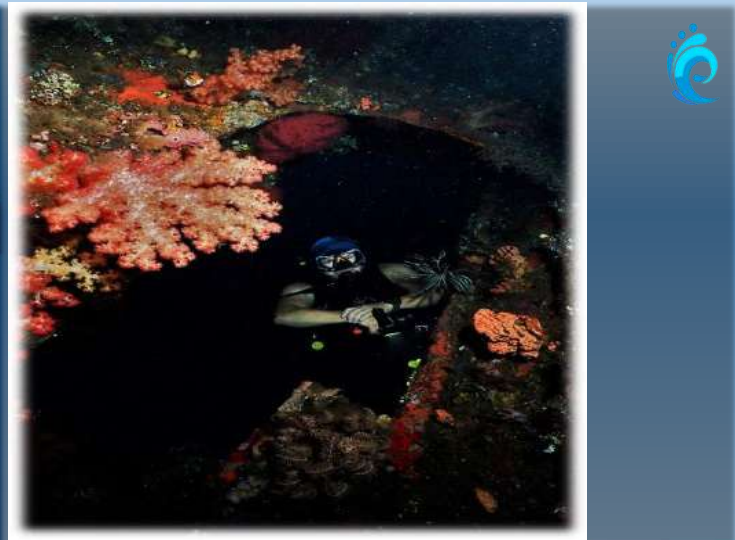
Another good morning. Your last day in the area of National Park. You can relax a little bit more after the breakfast to enjoy the resort before your relocation journey to the North east of Bali. The travel will take about 3 hours and we will make a stop at the Melanting Temple before your lunch at the nice beach restaurant. **Melanting Temple** is one of the most revered and beautiful temples in the region. Surrounded by stunning natural charm and a thick spiritual atmosphere, the temple offers a profound experience for visitors seeking peace and blessings.

DAY 5 : Tulamben 2x day shore + 1x shore night dive (3x dives)

Tulamben, on Bali's north-east coast, is renowned for its excellent shore diving, particularly the iconic Liberty shipwreck. The wreck is easily accessible from the shore and teeming with marine life, making it a popular spot for both beginners and experienced divers. Beyond the wreck, the area offers diverse dive sites like the Clownfish heaven and the Drop-off, further enhancing Tulamben's reputation as a top diving destination!

DAY 6 Tulamben 3x shore dives

Today you will explore different dive sites in Tulamben area. This village is indeed a fantastic destination for divers who enjoy macro photography, offering a variety of semi muck diving sites teeming with unique critters. Many sites, from the black sand slopes to nearby locations, provide excellent opportunities to find Frogfish, Ghost pipefish, Nudibranchs, Rhinopias, Harlequin shrimp and some more to discover!

Night in: Ocean View Resort Tulamben

DAY 7 Amed 2x boat dives

Amed is a traditional fishing village in north-eastern Bali renowned for its stunning diving and snorkeling, where you can find abundant coral reefs, easily spot turtles, and explore unique artificial reefs like the Pyramids. The unique site features pyramid-shaped structures made of concrete blocks, which were placed underwater by Balinese diving associations for coral regeneration in 1995 become a home sweet home for many different kinds of marine life.

DAY 8 Lipah bay 1x boat + 1x shore dive (2x dives)

This fishing village is almost on the tip of the eastern part of Bali. Lipah Karangasem Beach is indeed on the same coastline as Jemeluk and Amed beaches, so the typical beaches are almost the same. Lipah Beach itself is located in a bay, offering spectacular natural views of the blue sea. Not only that, the seawater on Lipah Karangasem beach is relatively clear, and the coral reefs are well preserved, so you can enjoy lots of coral fish easily, which is why the Lipah beach area is an ideal place for diving and recreational snorkeling.

Night in: Sea Mount Amed

DAY 9 Relocation Amed - Candidasa

Traveling from East Bali to Candidasa is a scenic experience, famous for its views of verdant rice terraces and the majestic Mount Agung. The region offers a quieter, more authentic glimpse into Balinese life compared to the more crowded south of the island. You will also visit The **Taman Ujung Sukasada** in Karang asem and also **The ancient Village** (Tenganan Pengeringsingan).

Night in: Sea Breeze Candidasa





DAY 10 Candidasa 2x boat dives

Scuba diving in Candidasa is simply amazing! The best dive sites are around the three small rocky islands of Gili Tepekong, Gili Biaha and Gili Mimpang. Many people say this is The best shark diving in Bali! And the visibility is often excellent. These islands are famous for the Sharks such as whitetip and blacktip reef Sharks.

Night in: Sea Breeze Candidasa

DAY 11 Relocation Candidasa – Sanur (2x dives)

Padang bay is a village in the Manggis District, Karangasem Regency, on the south-east side of Bali, Indonesia. The city is a ferry port for cruises to Lombok Island, Nusa Penida, the Gili Islands and other islands in West Nusa Tenggara.

its diverse marine life, vibrant reefs, and small shipwreck make it a distinctive and rewarding destination. Padang Bai is a paradise for macro photographers, with many sites known for their tiny and fascinating critters.

DAY 12 Nusa Penida 3x Boat Dives

Nusa Penida is the only region in Bali where you can regularly see Manta Rays all year round and Oceanic Sunfish (Mola-mola)– mainly between July to October. Nusa Penida is also home to over 500 species of reef fish, corals, and pelagic creatures including Thresher sharks, white tip reef sharks, eagle rays, and even Dolphins! blue-spotted stingrays, lionfish, octopus, moray eels, scorpionfish, soft corals, clownfish, butterflyfish, barracuda, trevally, snappers, sea turtles, pufferfish and there are a lot more to see!

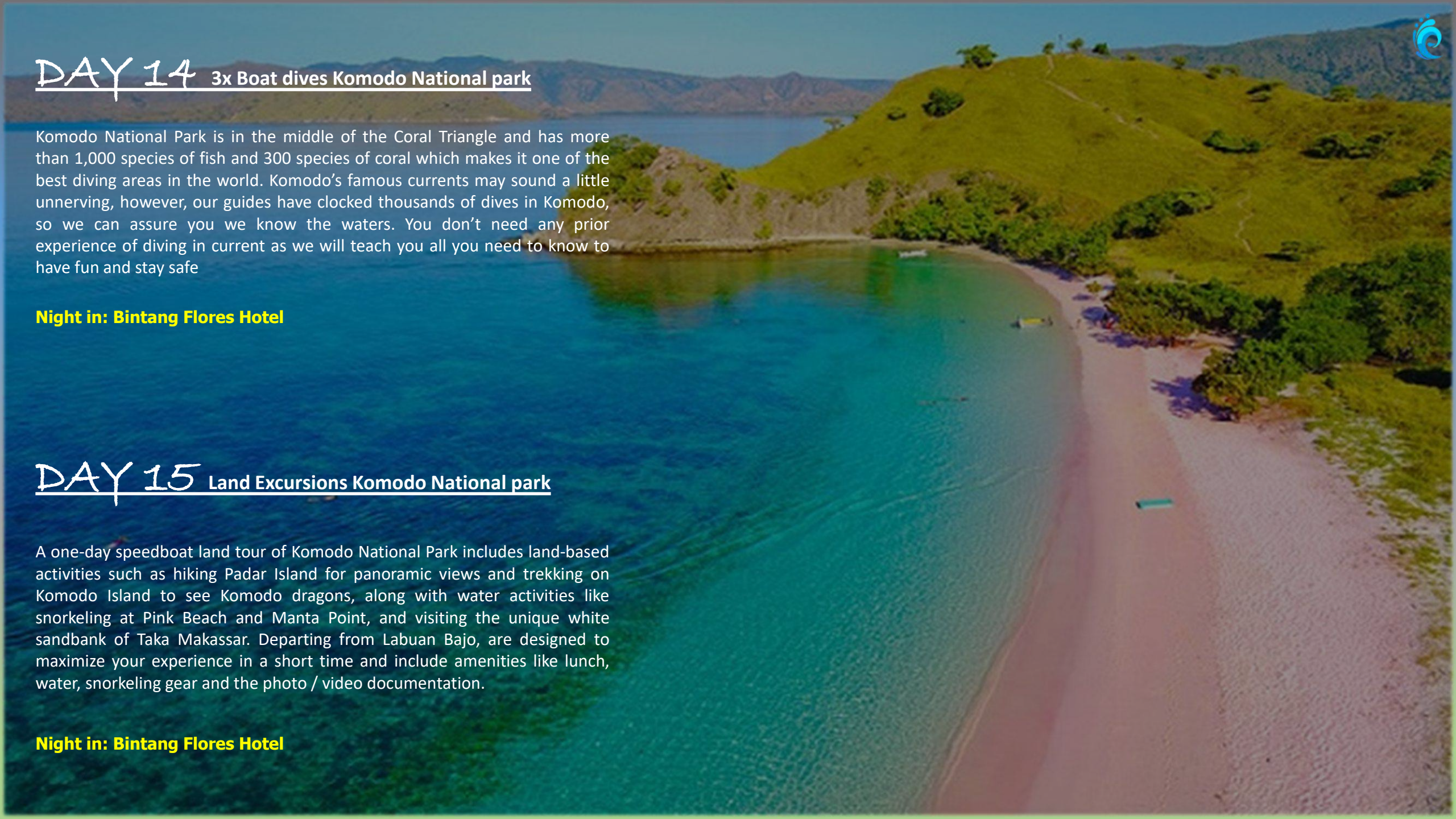
Night in: Prama Sanur

DAY 13 Relocation Bali – Labuan Bajo

You will get a transfer from the hotel in Bali to the airport (domestic terminal in Denpasar). About 1 hour flight to Labuan Bajo.

Is a small fishing village. Labuan Bajo is also the gateway to the nearby Komodo National Park on and around Komodo Island and Rinca Island, both home to the famous Komodo Dragon. The park is a World Heritage Site. Its islands offer good scuba diving.

DAY 14 3x Boat dives Komodo National park

Komodo National Park is in the middle of the Coral Triangle and has more than 1,000 species of fish and 300 species of coral which makes it one of the best diving areas in the world. Komodo's famous currents may sound a little unnerving, however, our guides have clocked thousands of dives in Komodo, so we can assure you we know the waters. You don't need any prior experience of diving in current as we will teach you all you need to know to have fun and stay safe

Night in: Bintang Flores Hotel

DAY 15 Land Excursions Komodo National park

A one-day speedboat land tour of Komodo National Park includes land-based activities such as hiking Padar Island for panoramic views and trekking on Komodo Island to see Komodo dragons, along with water activities like snorkeling at Pink Beach and Manta Point, and visiting the unique white sandbank of Taka Makassar. Departing from Labuan Bajo, are designed to maximize your experience in a short time and include amenities like lunch, water, snorkeling gear and the photo / video documentation.
