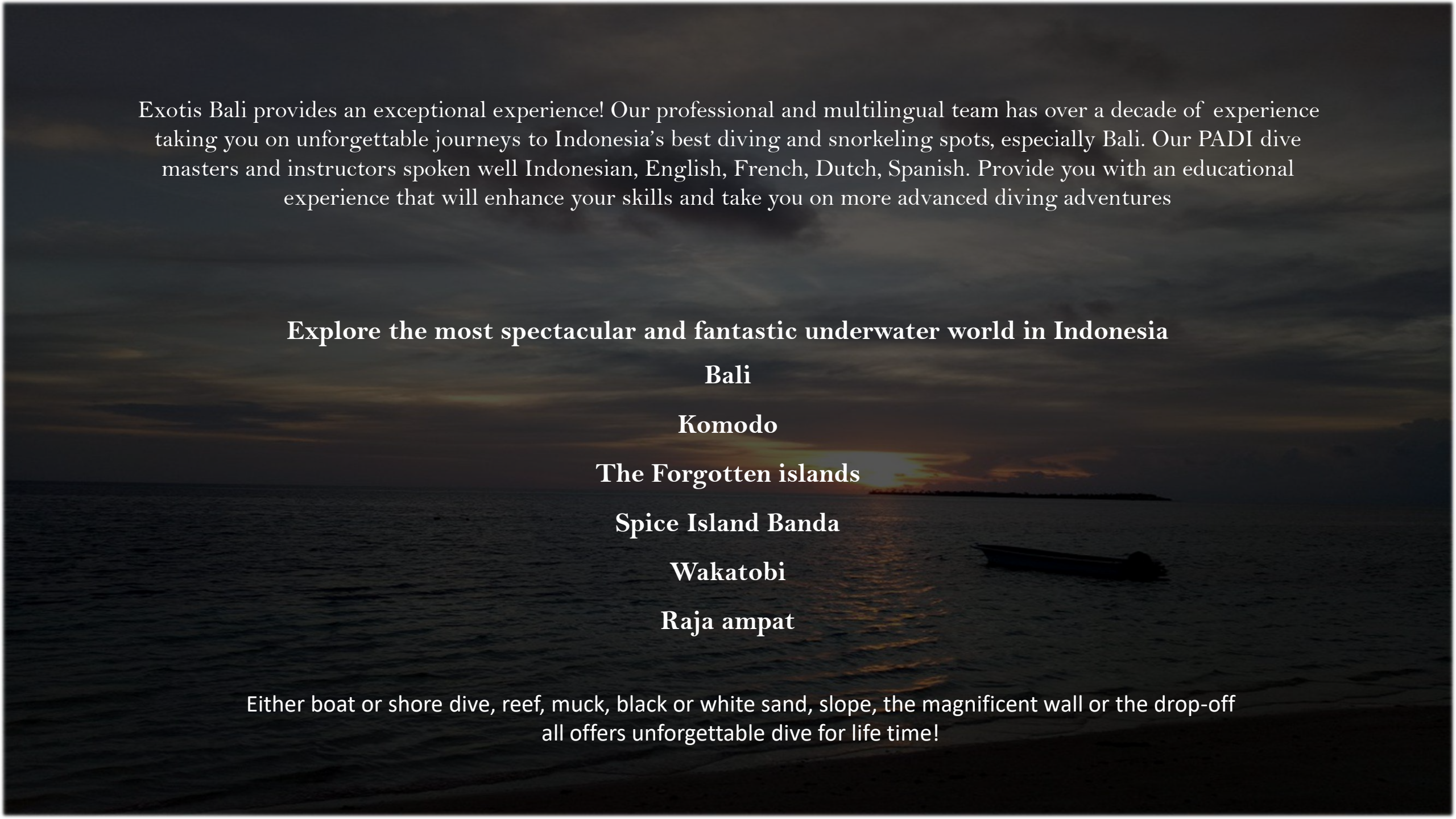

DAY 1 TULAMBEN 3X SHORE DIVES

You will discover the most famous dive site of Asia, the shipwreck of the USAT Liberty 1942 measuring 120 meters long. The ship used to be an US cargo ship used during the second world war II. After being torpedoed the ship ended up on the beach of Tulamben where it remained until 1963. After the tremors of the Mt. Agung, the ship ended up in the ocean where it remained until this day. The ship wreck rests at a depth of 10- to 30m and is a truly impressive sight.

In the afternoon you will discover The Drop-off, another spot known for its fauna. This wall is covered by a great number of corals, gorgonians, and sponges. The topography of the site is incredible thanks to its sheer underwater cliffs, where you can encounter “cleaning stations”, as well as a multitude of enormous, vibrantly colored sponges and gorgonians. The dive continues to an undulating plateau of coral where you can find morays, mantis shrimp, and varieties of pipefish hiding in the crevices.

You will also make a night dive on Liberty Shipwreck! It will become one of your best night dive in life! You will find the giant grouper and the giant moray eel hunting for the small fish together with night divers.

DAY 2 TULAMBEN 3X SHORE DIVES

You will discover the most popular dive sites for Macro Lovers! Easy shore dives on volcanic black sand where most of the critters you don't see often on the reef such as ghost pipefish, frogfish, harlequin shrimp, and a lot of different nudibranch such as shaun the sheep nudibranch, dotto nudibranch, flabelina, and more to discover!

There are many of them for Macro sites such as Seraya, Melasti, Kuwanji, Batuniti, Gerombong, Etc.

You will also explore the Boga shipwreck 2012 in kubu. This ship is amazing where you can make easy penetration inside the wreck. Corals are growth healthy and full of fish! The safari VW car also make this site even more interesting to explore!

DAY 3 AMED 3X DIVES

The driver will pick you up in the morning at the lobby and drive for about 30 minutes toward Amed. You will then explore the site we call Pyramides.

This site is one of the most successful artificial reef created by local divers in the past. Offers dazzling of marine life, the pyramides shapes made by concrete blocks covered with full of hard – soft corals make this site a home sweet home of small fish where it attracts the bigger fish! And The Jemeluk wall is a nice Drop-off up to about 30 to 50 meters depth offers stunning wall! The boat dives using a traditional wooden fishing boat. Shore to dive sites about less than 5 minutes.

Lunch in between the dives. In the afternoon when all done, we will take you to your hotel for the night in Amed.

DAY 4 LIPAH BAY 2X BOAT DIVES

The driver will pick you up in the morning at the lobby and drive for about 30 minutes further east, exactly right on the east tip of Bali island. Not many divers come to this area due to its distance especially from the city of Denpasar.

The pristine reef of Gili Selang where it is good habitat for the white tip shark and a lot of different types of tropical fish and if you are lucky you might see the hammerhead shark!

The boat ride is about 10 minutes with local boat. Back to the shore after the 1st dive, then you will explore the Japanese shipwreck after your surface interval. Nice easy shore dive and it is quiet shallow where it makes the color of the corals more bright and beautiful!

DAY 5 PADANG BAY 2X BOAT DIVES

Our team will come to pick you up at your hotel and driving for about 1 hour to Padang Bay. Then you will board on a diving boat ride to dive sites around 10 minutes.

After the 2x boat dives, you will come back to the shore for lunch at the beach restaurant where you can have the shower too in this place.

The small village that offers amazing attractions for most of the divers in Bali. White sand with full of critters you can photograph such as Pegasus seamount, sea horse, stingrays, shrimps and many different type of crabs and frogfish! You will see a small shipwreck too here at about 20m / 60 ft deep.

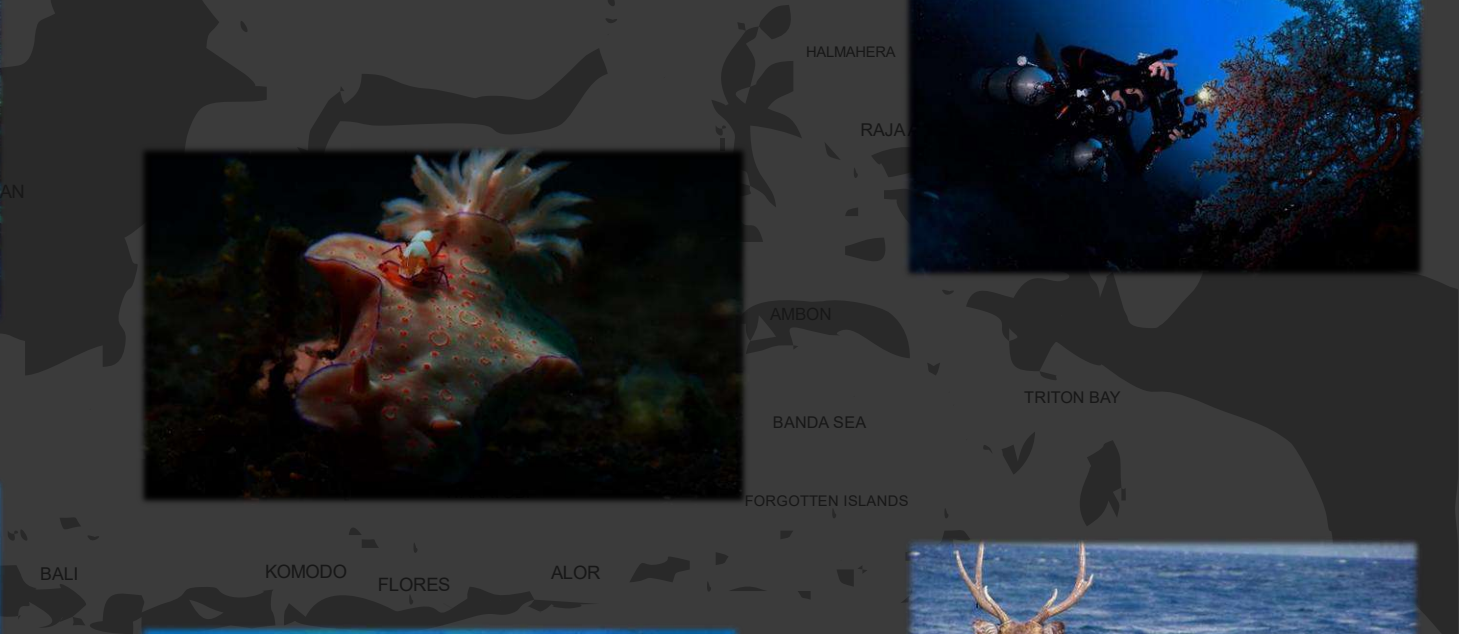


DAY 6 NUSA PENIDA 3X BOAT DIVES

Nusa Penida is also home to over 500 species of reef fish, corals, and pelagic creatures including Manta Rays, thresher sharks, eagle rays, and even Dolphins! Cold thermoclines rising from the deep ranging from 17-20 °C/62-68°F. Preserve the coral reef by clearing away particles that might obstruct sunlight and bring nutrients to nourish the reef, and also a good chance to see the iconic creature in the area Oceanic Sunfish – Mola-mola.
